

Process of Admission of Special Children in School

The admission process of special children in school is designed in the following manner:

The admission process of school is of 3 days in which the special child along with his/her parents or guardians have to come to the school for the assessment of child. The process is of 2 to 3 hours daily for 3 days. To assess the present level of the special child, various examination are done such as psychological test, speech and language test, physio test and educational & functional test.

After the examination of the child, the multi-disciplinary team of the school which has done the assessment, discuss with the parents on what kind of services can be given to the child. The services include:

- **Inclusive Class**: - Class where normal and special children are taught together. Child is given admission in class 1 to 5 according to his/her ability. Or the child can also be admitted in special class where the special educators teach the students on the basis of I.E.P.
- **Community based rehabilitation Program**: - The child is given weekly, fortnightly or monthly program at his home by the CBR teacher and it is tried that child gets admission in normal school.
- **Early Intervention Center**: - If the child is at the age of 0-6 years then he/she is admitted to our Early Intervention Center at Panchsheel, Ajmer.
- **Residential School**: - The students can live in the school campus and can get the education and training. This facility is specially for the children who are not having special education facility nearby.
- **Daksha Vocational Training Center**: - Students are trained on various job related vocational work.
- Students with specific learning disability or having behavior problem or autism are given personal one to one programme.
